Your abstract can only be accepted for publication in conferences proceedings if the following conditions are met.

Guidelines for abstracts:

The total length, including figures, tables, and references should be **between 2-4 pages**, spaced at 1, using Times New Roman 12 with standard margins.

- 1. The title of the paper (max 10 words), 14 TNR, bold,**
- 2. The names of the authors , employer/institution and e-mail address(es) of the authors, for instance:**

Robert^{1*} and Peter²

- 3. Key words (max 5), for instance:**

Keywords: logistics, food supply chain, sustainability, transport

- 4. Structure of the abstract paper as follows:**

- Introduction,
- Methods,
- Findings,
- Conclusions and Implications,
- References.

- 5. Citations in the text should be structured as follows:**

a) For cited sources in the text the format should be as follows: one author: (Johansson, 2014); two authors: (Kotany and Christopher, 2013), if more than 2 authors, list the first and then add et al.: (Mankowicz, et al., 2014) .

b) Citations in the text of books and research reports for instance: (European Commission, 2012, p. 63): include the page number(s) of the book/report.

6. Citations of articles in the references list should be structured as follows.

Johansson P. A. (2013). The logistics systems in Armenia. *Logistics Systems*, vol. 2(3): 11 – 26.

If more than one author:

Michelson P. A, Moore V.A. (2012). Study of CSR in Greece. *International Journal of CSR*, vol. 2(3): 101 – 116.

7. Citations of books, reports and internet sources in the references list should be structured as follows.

- Alexander A., Velon J.A., Piterson P. (2013). *Regional Agribusiness*. Helion, New York.
- OECD (2000). *Logistics Integration in the Asia-Pacific Region*, OECD, Paris.
- <http://www.agrifoodlogistics.eu> [date of access; for example 11.03.2014]
